VARIETY INFORMATION TECHNOTE

Skip Row Specialist

MR-Maxi has proven to be one of the most consistent hybrids when grown under skip-row conditions. Its excellent pre and post flowering resistance, stress tolerance and mid season maturity make it ideal for skip row planting.

Synchronous tillering habit

MR-Maxi is a good tillering hybrid and can produce two to three tillers per plant. These all flower at the same time resulting in easy management and maximum yield potential.

Midge tested rating of three

A midge tested rating of three means MR-Maxi can tolerate three times the number of midge than a non midge susceptible variety.

Planting recommendations

MR-Maxi has produced excellent yields from the Liverpool Plains to Central Queensland. MR-Maxi is recommended for the main planting time in all areas.
